A JOURNEY BEGINS WITH A SINGLE STEP

Most families do not have the resources to cope with the incredibly difficult grieving process following a death, especially when young children and teenagers are involved. Suncoast Kids Place provides understanding and support in a safe and nurturing environment. Children, teens, and families can share their experience as they move through the process of grieving the death of a significant person.

Through peer support groups, discussion, education, and play, Suncoast Kids Place provides the resources necessary to help families grieve a devastating death. Families also find strength and joy in sharing memories of someone special. Here, participants have the opportunity to meet others who have also experienced the death of a parent, primary caregiver, sibling, friend, or other significant person.

Caregivers are encouraged to attend the adult group that meets concurrently with most of the onsite children's groups. It is required that an adult caregiver remain on campus.

All groups are led by professional staff members and trained volunteer facilitators. Therapy dogs are also a key component to the children and teen group sessions.

Suncoast Kids Place does not provide private therapy.

Children and teens that are not supported during grief can develop serious emotional and behavioral problems that may follow them throughout their lives.

At Suncoast Kids Place, we help families, teens, and children work through this very important grieving process.

GET INVOLVED AS A FAMILY

Suncoast Kids Place provides support for children and teens, ages 3-18, and their families following the death of a significant person through peer support groups and education. Our goal is to offer support in a safe place where children, teens, and families can share their experience as they grieve.

VOLUNTEER WITH SKP

The success of Suncoast Kids Place is highly dependent on volunteers. The fact is, it cannot happen without them.

A Volunteer Facilitator's commitment to each group is 2.5 hours twice a month. Volunteers will interact directly with the children or teens during play and talk time and will work to establish a relationship with the children that are working through the death of a significant person.

Volunteer facilitators are also an important part of our caregiver groups. They assist in leading conversations amongst the caregivers who bring the children to our program. Most child/teen groups have a co-occurring caregiver group.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMMING AND EDUCATION

A goal of Suncoast Kids Place is to provide training and education to increase the community's awareness of the needs of grieving children. We provide presentations and in-service training on many topics and can accommodate the specific needs of a school, organization, or business.

Suncoast Kids Place School Initiative also provides three levels of support to our local schools including education and groups.
